**NARRATIVE: ON 9/6/03 AT 8:27PM MEDFORD TOWNSHIP POLICE RECEIVED A CALL OF A VEHICLE IN THE POOL AT THE FLYING W RESTAURANT ON FOSTERTOWN RD. UPON ARRIVAL POLICE FOUND A 1992 CHEVROLET CORSICA IN THE POOL. A 17 YEAR OLD FEMALE DRIVER HAD BEEN PULLED FROM THE VEHICLE, SHE WAS UNINJURED. POLICE INVESTIGATION REVEALS THE FEMALE DRIVER HAD PARKED HER VEHICLE IN THE LOT OF THE FLYING W. UPON LEAVING THE ESTABLISHMENT SHE BACKED HER CAR FROM THE PARKING SPACE, IN DOING SO SHE STRUCK A VEHICLE TO HER REAR. AT THAT POINT SHE DROVE HER VEHICLE FORWARD, THROUGH A FENCE AND INTO THE POOL RECREATION AREA. THE VEHICLE TRAVELLED THROUGH THE POOL AREA, STRIKING NUMEROUS CHAIRS. A 13 YEAR OLD BOY NEAR THE FENCE IN THE POOL AREA WAS INJURED WHILE TRYING TO AVOID THE VEHICLE AT THAT TIME. THE VEHICLE THEN WENT THROUGH ANOTHER FENCE AND ONTO THE SIDEWALK BY THE RESTAURANT. THE VEHICLE THEN TURNED BACK TOWARDS THE POOL AREA, JUMPED A CURB AND WENT BACK THROUGH THE FENCE AGAIN AND INTO THE POOL AREA. THE VEHICLE THEN WENT INTO THE POOL . THREE BYSTANDERS WENT INTO THE POOL AND PULLED**

**DRIVER 1 FROM THE VEHICLE. THE 13 YEAR OLD BOY WAS TRANSPORTED BY MT LAUREL EMS TO MHBC, WHERE HE WAS TREATED AND RELEASED. DRIVER 1, WHO WAS NOT INJURED, WAS SUBSEQUENTLY TAKEN INTO CUSTODY.
